CFS Jeremiah, Quaysaun, and Brianna Mom: Ryneesha	Ms. Nance lost her job this summer. She is struggling, but she remains a very active parent volunteer with CFS and helps out at UrbanPromise. She helps out as a lunch aide and cleans the kitchen in the Faith building. Ms. Nance needs assistance with electric and water bills totaling \$608.00. We would also like \$400.00 for Christmas and food.
CFS Ignacio & Katelyn Mom: Luz	In need of financial assistance since her husband walked out on her and the kids a few weeks ago. He was the primary financial support in the household. Ms. Garcia needs assistance with \$500 for food, gifts and other household needs.
CFS Ivan & Imere Mom: Precious	Mother has been hospitalized in ICU. She is the primary bread winner in the family. Family is in dire need of financial assistance to include PSE&G bill for \$500, Comcast bill for \$500, and \$500 for food and household needs. Also seeking four months of wages (Ms. Stevens is the aide for the CFS after school program), totaling \$2,000, which we'll deploy monthly. Total need: \$3,500.
CFS Karie, Khalil and Karim Mom: Gabriela	Single parent raising 3 boys on a limited income. She has been having difficulty with landlord fixing troubled areas in the home which makes living there unbearable (rodent infestation). \$300 for groceries and \$400 for extermination and repairing home issues.
CFS Alexander Mom: Clover	Ms. Harris is unemployed. Her son has asthma and he has to visit the hospital frequently. Needs financial assistance with holiday to include food \$300.
CFS Samir Mom: Iris	Ms. Thomas works 2 jobs to take care of family and husband is incarcerated. She is struggling to take care of all the financial obligations including mortgage. \$300 for food and Christmas.
CFS Brian Mom: Crystal	Being taken care of by his aunt. His aunt is struggling to pay tuition because she has her own child to provide for. Brian's mom has four children of her own and Brian is the oldest child (he's in kindergarten). \$300 for food and Christmas.
CFS Kanya Mom: Ms. Lingo	Mom is a single parent and her brother just passed away. She is in need of financial assistance because she had to help with funeral expenses. \$300 for food and Christmas.
Amber (13) Camp Freedom	The mother (Ms. Carmen) is unemployed and struggling to make ends meet. Amber is in need of glasses, and the family is requesting \$300 to help with this need, and \$250 for groceries. Total of \$550.
Mark (14) Camp Freedom	Mark lives with his grandmother and her disability money was cut. Mark only eats dinner at after-school program, not on weekends. Requesting \$300 for food and Christmas gifts. After-school director will help with ongoing grocery needs.
Daionni (7) Daishon (11) Damiyah (14)	Parents are divorced, and the family is really struggling financially. Requesting \$400 for food and Christmas gifts. After-school program director will help the family with ongoing grocery needs.

Two South Camden families involved in Camp Freedom In need of groceries, Tony Vega will buy and deliver groceries	Graham (family of four) and Veguiella (family of four). These two families have very little food in their homes, the children only eat dinner at after-school programs (not on weekends).
Diamond Grandmother: Cathyn Afterschool program	Diamond and her siblings live with her grandmother and they have very little money. Requesting \$300 for food and Christmas gifts.
Arie (4 <sup>th</sup> grade) Camp Freedom	Family of 5; single mom needs help with gifts and groceries for the daughters. Requesting \$200
Victoria (3 <sup>rd</sup> grade) Victoria (1 <sup>st</sup> grade)	Mother has requested help occasionally. There are other older siblings living at home (late teens/early 20's), trying to help support the family. Mom is pregnant, and struggling with supporting children. A \$300 gift card for food is requested.
Le'Dion and Demanda (elementary, afterschool programs)	In need of clothing, Christmas gifts, and food. \$300 is requested.
Jakhi and Jakhia (elementary, afterschool programs)	In need of clothing, Christmas gifts, and food. \$300 is requested.
Cassidy (1 <sup>st</sup> grade) and Adrian (4 <sup>th</sup> grade) Afterschool program, Camp Joy	They haven't had electricity for a month and the parents have not been open to outside help. UrbanPromise staff is trying to convince them to take part in the Emergency Family Fund. \$600 is requested.
Jah'Chiriah Camp Freedom	Mother is making a major move out of the housing projects, but she needs help with the security deposit, \$800.
Deannah (4 <sup>th</sup> grade) Camp Freedom	A family of five, single mom. In need of groceries and a winter coat for Deannah. A grocery card (\$250) and Target card (\$100) is requested.
Tamia (3 <sup>rd</sup> grade) & Ashanti (5 <sup>th</sup> grade) Camp Freedom	\$500 is requested to pay utilities.
Felix (3 <sup>rd</sup> grade)	Family of 3, single mom, struggling to provide. Would like \$200 grocery card.

Emmanuel (High School)	Current StreetLeader at UrbanPromise. He lives with his mother and there is often a shortage of food in the house. \$300 requested for groceries
Shakira	She is a former UrbanPromise Streetleader with 4 children. Her younger brother attends Faith AfterSchool Program. Shakira and her 4 children live with her mother and her younger brother. She is in school and thus has very limited income. Requesting gift cards between \$300-\$400 are being requested for food and Christmas presents for the children.
Jalisa	\$2,000 for tuition is needed. She was admitted to UPA knowing that mother cannot pay tuition.
Cafee	\$150 for clothing (especially UrbanPromise Academy) is needed. Cafee is a junior, and is the oldest sibling amongst seven children.
Ruby	Ruby is a new student who has moved to Merchantville to live with her biological mother who is in the final stages of cancer. She is a caretaker of her sick mother. A \$200 gift card is requested for Christmas gifts.
Dajah (16)	Family needs help with groceries, utility bills (water and electric), and gifts for siblings (total of 5: oldest brother is 25 and is autistic; older sisters Dominique and Monique are 19 years old; Dajah is 16; and younger brother is 12 years old). Total needs: \$1,500
Emmanuel (18)	He and his 17 year old brother are currently living with their grandmother; however she doesn't want them there and isn't caring for them. Their mother struggles with addiction, so they cannot live with her. They will most likely not be receiving any Christmas gifts and they have an immediate need for food in the house. UrbanPromise StreetLeader Director wants to provide a great Christmas meal, presents, and food for the family. \$500
Dwayne (17)	He is currently living with friends. His mother passed away a few years ago and his father is in and out of prison. He needs help with groceries and paying the electric bill. UrbanPromise staff is working to help him find a home and stability, as well as Christmas meals and presents. \$600 is requested.
Jeffrey (18)	Family is in need of \$100 for a wheel alignment for their car.
Ashley (16)	The family of 4 needs \$400 to help with groceries and gifts for Ashley and her two younger siblings, ages 8 and 10.
Annie Huyhn (18)	Annie is an awesome young woman. Every other month the utilities are shut off. All of Annie's StreetLeader check goes towards food and utilities. The StreetLeader staff would like to provide food and utilities for three months, \$1,000.
Elizabeth Perez (16)	Family needs help with paying utilities (electric and water) and also needs assistance with buying groceries. Her grandmother recently passed away, and her mother does not want to celebrate Christmas this year, so Elizabeth and her younger sister (age 13 and a current camp kid at Camp Spirit), most likely won't be receiving any gifts. The StreetLeader staff are planning to take the children out for a meal and gifts, in addition to utilities and groceries. \$800
